The second death anniversary of Professor Dr. M. Alimullah Miyan, the pioneer of private universities in Bangladesh, was observed on Thursday and Sunday, 10 and 12 May at 3:00 pm at IUBAT. A Khatam-e-Quran, a Doa Mahfil, a free health campaign and inauguration of IUBAT Mosque were held for eternal peace of the departed soul of Dr Miyan.

A memorial meeting was also arranged at the campus which was an opportunity for many of his colleagues and students to pay homage to him. To engrave his memory, the Dr M Alimullah Miyan Research Center was inaugurated and five students were given Dr Miyan Scholarship worth nearly 21 lakh taka.

Engineer Wasil Hasan Chowdhury, Secretary of the Board of Trustees of IUBAT, Vice-Chancellor Professor Dr Abdur Rab, Pro Vice Chancellor Dr Hamida Akther Begum, whole community of IUBAT, Dr Miyan's well-wishers and relatives joined the program to pray for the salvation of his soul. IUBAT Founder Prof Dr M Alimullah Miyan

Born in Comilla, Bangladesh, Dr M Alimullah Miyan is the pioneer of non-government university in Bangladesh. He founded the International University of Business Agriculture and Technology (IUBAT) in Dhaka, the first non-government University in Bangladesh. After completing his Honours and Masters degrees at Dhaka University, he received his MBA at Indiana University, USA and his Doctorate at Manchester Business School, UK. Dr Miyan's distinguished and varied academic career has included the positions of Vice-Chancellor at IUBAT, Director and Professor at Institute of Business Administration (IBA) of Dhaka University (DU), and Founder Chairman of the Centre for Population Management and Research (CPMR) at DU. Dr Miyan served as President of IUBAT upon its founding in 1991 before moving into his role of Vice-Chancellor in 1994. Dr Miyan authored 46 academic articles and is author/co-author of 15 books on a wide range of topics related to the promotion of business, sustainable development, education, development and disaster management in Bangladesh, social safety

(pension), climate change, family planning, industrial relations, energy policy and the like. Dr Miyan was also involved in numerous research and consultancy projects and he participated in many conferences, seminars and workshops around the world. Dr Miyan was a member of the Executive Committee of the International Society for Labor and Social Security Law in Geneva, Switzerland, Founding Executive Member of the Association of Management Development Institutions in South Asia (AMDISA) and President of Rotary Club of Greater Dhaka. He has studied in the United States, Great Britain, worked in Nigeria for a semester and has visited 41 countries as part of his academic activities and in pursuit of excellence for his beloved country.
